CADD Prizm Battery Change Procedure

Properly administering your medication at home is important to your safety. In the event of an emergency, always call 911.

Note: If the yellow and green light on the top right corner of the pump starts blinking, and a "**9-volt Battery Low"** or "**9-volt Battery Depleted"** or "**Battery Low"** message appears on the display screen, you should change the battery. Use a 9-volt alkaline or lithium battery.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

9 volt battery

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Stop CADD Prizm pump. Press START/STOP key. When you see Stop the Pump? press "Y".
- 2. Press the button on the battery door and slide the battery door forward. Remove the used battery.
- 3. Match the + and markings on the new battery with the markings on the pump. Insert the new battery. The pump will beep if the battery is inserted correctly.
- 4. Replace the battery door. The pump will power up automatically.
- 5. Restart pump. Press STOP/START key. When you see **Start the pump?**, press "Y".
- 6. **Starting pump** will appear on the main screen. The pump will automatically review and display the preprogrammed settings.
- 7. Running will appear on the screen, the green light will blink, and medication delivery will begin.
- 8. Place CADD Prizm pump back in carrying pouch.
